Isaiah 54:8 (TEV) - I turned away angry for only a moment, but I will show you my love forever." So says the LORD who saves you.

John 13:34 (CEV) - But I am giving you a new command. You must love each other, just as I have loved you.

1 Corinthians 13:7 (ICB) - Love patiently accepts all things. It always trusts, always hopes, and always continues strong.

1 Corinthians 13:7 (ESV) - Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Bears – **στῆγῶ**; **Transliterated Word: stegô**;

Romans 3:10 (NCV) - As the Scriptures say: "There is no one who always does what is right, not even one.

1 John 1:8 (TLB) - If we say that we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and refusing to accept the truth.

Matthew 6:14-15 (NCV) - Yes, if you forgive others for their sins, your Father in heaven will also forgive you for your sins. ¹⁵ But if you don't forgive others, your Father in heaven will not forgive your sins.

Romans 15:7 (NIV) - Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.

Ephesians 4:2 (NLT) - Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love.

1 Corinthians 13:7 (ESV) - Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Believes – **πιστεύω**; **Transliterated Word: pisteuô**;

1 John 4:18-19 (ESV) - There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love. ¹⁹ We love because he first loved us.

2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 (NLT) - Now may our Lord Jesus Christ himself and God our Father, who loved us and by his grace gave us eternal comfort and a wonderful hope, ¹⁷ comfort you and strengthen you in every good thing you do and say.

1 Corinthians 13:7 (ESV) - Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Endures – Greek Word: □πομ□νω; **Transliterated Word:** *Hupomenô*;

1 Corinthians 13:8 (NLT) - Prophecy and speaking in unknown languages and special knowledge will become useless. But love will last forever!

James 5:11 (NLT) - We give great honor to those who endure under suffering. For instance, you know about Job, a man of great endurance. You can see how the Lord was kind to him at the end, for the Lord is full of tenderness and mercy.
